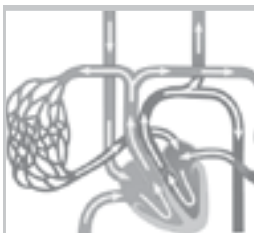
The **circulatory system** is a transport system. It consists of the heart, blood vessels, and blood. (pp. 144-147)
