Liquid water can evaporate and turn into water vapor. Water vapor in the air can form clouds, fog, rain, hail, sleet, or snow.

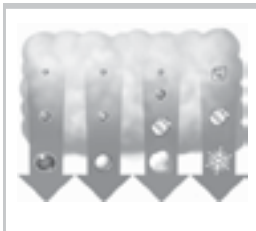

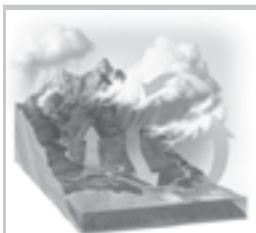
Condensation occurs when a gas changes into a liquid. **Evaporation** occurs when water changes from a liquid to a gas. (pp. 190-195)
