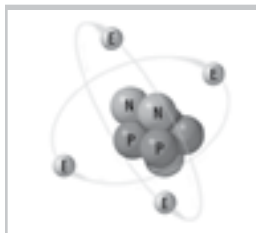

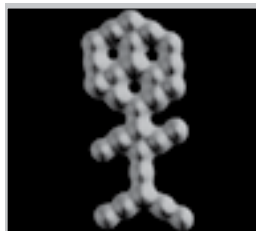
Each **element** is made of one kind of atom. Elements are found as atoms or molecules. (pp. 364–365)
