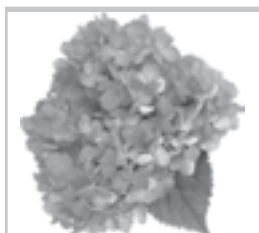
Salts have high melting points, are hard and brittle, and conduct electricity when dissolved. (pp. 436–437)
